General information on the operating rules of school clubs:

SJS responsibilities

- To coordinate the school clubs offered by staff and communicate these activities to families
- To liaise with ESF Educational Services and other private providers as needed and support the operation of their after school clubs
- To manage bookings for school clubs offered by ESF Educational Services and other private providers
- To give advance notice to ESF Educational Services and other private providers of those school events (e.g parent-teacher consultations) which prevent normal operation of their school clubs

We apologise in advance that occasionally, due to school events, room changes may have to be made at short notice.

In the interest of health and safety and security:

Parents' Responsibilities

- Children must not be left unsupervised on the school premises after 3.00pm. There is no supervision provided after 3.00pm. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to supervise their children before and after the activity sessions. Parents of children left unsupervised will be contacted and asked to collect their children if left without supervision after 3.00pm.
- Students must be collected promptly from the playground at the end of each club from the large undercover area. They should not wander around the school, into the car park or play in the playground.
- Parents/guardians remain downstairs in the playground and wait for their child/ren to complete their school club. Parent/guardians are also not permitted to wander in the school during school clubs.
- Siblings not involved in clubs on that day **SHOULD NOT BE WAITING BEHIND AFTER SCHOOL TO GO**

HOME WITH THEIR BROTHERS OR SISTERS. This includes students waiting for siblings to finish school at Sha Tin College. We regret that these students are not permitted to be on the school grounds.

- Bus escorts must be informed of all students attending school clubs

Students' Responsibilities

- Students are expected to wait with their parent/guardian in the playground – they are not permitted to play or wander about in the school after 3.00pm
- Students are expected to meet their school club tutor in the main playground (large undercover area) at the meeting point designated by the tutor.
- Students are expected to return to this meeting point in the large undercover area and reunite with their parent/guardian.
- Students are expected to participate fully and exhibit good behaviour during all school clubs.

SCHOOL CLUBS

School clubs or extra curricular activities are provided for children and operate outside of the normal school timetable. The school club programme is organised to encourage students to pursue other interests beyond the classroom. School clubs provide enrichment opportunities in a variety of areas such as sport, languages, creative writing, construction, mathematics, performing art, science, thinking skills and technology. All school clubs are voluntary. The aims of the programme are to:

- extend and build on the school curriculum
- provide encourage student participation
- further develop social skills and team work

Activities are scheduled throughout the school year and take place after school, during lunchtimes and at weekends.

Currently, there are three types of school clubs. These clubs are as follows:

1. Clubs led by Sha Tin Junior staff – generally these are free of charge although there may be a small material or transport cost for some activities
2. Clubs led by ESF Educational Services – fee payment required to participate
3. Clubs led by other private providers – fee payment required to participate
